

Hans van de Waarsenburg was born 1943 in Helmond, from 1966 lives in Masstricht. His first book of poetry was simply entitled, *Gedichten (Poems)*. So far he has published twenty plus books of poetry, *Zuidwall / South Wall* (1995), *Beschrijvingen van het meer / Descriptions of the Lake* (2000; Slovenian edition 2007) and others. His selected poems were published in Bulgaria, English edition, *Selected Poems I and II*, was published 2001 (B. A. C., Paris), and his *Selected Poems (1980-200)* were published in Macedonian (Blesok, Skopje, 2002).

Hans van de Waarsenburg published ten books for children, and for the book of poems, *De Vergrijzing*, received Jan Campert Prize (1972). He was president of the Dutch PEN Centre (1995-2001) and program coordinator of distinguished international literary festival, "The Maastricht International Poetry Nights".
