

Drago Glamuzina was born 1967 in Vrgorac. He earned his degree in comparative literature and philosophy at the Zagreb University. From 1999 till 2003 he was an editor in the weekly magazine *Nacional*. Currently he is manager at the publishing house Profil International.

Glamuzina published a book of poetry *Mesari / Butchers* (Naklada MD, Zagreb, 2001) and subsequently received the Nazor Annual prize for the best book of poetry in 2001, and in the same year the Kvirin prize for poetry.

The book *Mesari / Butchers* was translated in Slovenian (Litera, Maribor) and Macedonian (Makedonska knjiga, Skoplje), and some poems were translated in English and German language.

With Roman Simić he has edited an anthology of Croatian erotic short stories, *Libido.hr. – hrvatska erotska priča* (Naklada MD, Zagreb 2002).
