



Julijana Matanović was born in 1959 in Gradačac, Bosnia and Herzegovina. Since 1962 she lives in Croatia. She earned her BA in Yugoslav literature from Faculty of Education in Osijek, finished postgraduate studies in Zagreb and earned her MA with the thesis, "Primary and secondary generic features in Đurđević's *Shighs of Magdalene the Humble*". In 1998 she earned her PhD with the thesis "Croatian historical novel in 20 century". From the year 2000 she is a docent at the department for Modern Croatian Literature, University of Zagreb, in charge for the postgraduate study of the Croatian Literature.

She was the head of the Literary Club at Student Centre in Osijek, and of the Literary Friday in Zagreb, and in charge for the edition "Hit". From April 2003 till April 2004 she was an editor in chief in the Publishing House Matica hrvatska; currently she is a member of the editorial board for the literary magazine "Književne revija". She is writing criticism and editorials for the daily paper "Vijesnik".

Her novel, *Zašto sam vam lagala*, was published in Slovenia, Germany, Czech Republic, and in Serbia (2003).
