

Bojan Radašinović was born in 1975 in Zagreb. He had a number of odd jobs, working as literary critic for magazines, journalist, DJ, farmer, salesman, assistant technician, and volunteer in nongovernmental organizations. Currently he works as a pedagogue for preschool children, and he is the computer mentor in the Society For Gifted Children.

So far he has had three books of poetry published: *Sprega književnosti i prljavog rublja / Bond Of Literature With Dirty Laundry* (SKUD I. G. Kovačić, Zagreb, 2000), for which he received the annual Goran Prize For Young Poets in 2000, *Ovdje ćemo uvijek biti stranci / We Will Always Be Strangers Here* (AGM, Zagreb, 2003) and *Savršeno mjesto za život / Perfect Place For Living* (AGM, Zagreb, 2005).

He says that without his consent – "Nobody asked me!" – some of his poems were translated and published in Slovenia, and he also claims that he is happily in love, again.
