She has published a collection of poetry, *Nešto nije u redu?* (Meandar, Zagreb, 2000), German and Slovenian edition, short novel, *Crnac* (Durieux, Zagreb, 2004), Polish and Slovenian edition, recorded on CD (MKC, Split, 2006), and a book of nonfiction, *Bijele vrane* (Profil, Zagreb, 2005), Slovenian edition. She is co-author of the book *Last & Lost* (Surhkamp, Frankfurt, 2006), Polish and French edition.

Her fiction, essays and poetry has been published in Croatian literature magazines and abroad, and she attended many European literary festivals.
