She writes poetry, essays, plays and short stories (for later she received Annual Awards from literary magazine *Vijenac* and daily paper *Večernji list*). She has published books of poetry *Plahta preko glave* (IGK, Zagreb 1999; "Goran" Award for young poets), *Thamagochi mi je umro na rukama*, (Meandar, Zagreb 2001) *Đavo i usidjelica* (AGM, Zagreb 2003), *Kvadratura duge* (AGM, Zagreb 2007) and a book of short stories *Kičma* (2009). Her poetry was included in poetry anthologies, and her poems were translated and published in English, German, Polish, Romanian, Hungarian, Macedonian and Slovenian language. She has received Balkan Grand Prize for Poetry (2007) at International poetry festival in Romania. She works as theater instructor and directs student theatre groups in Zagreb.
