

Zoran Ferić was born 1961 in Zagreb. He graduated South Slavic literatures at Philosophical Faculty in Zagreb 1989, and works as high school professor of Croatian literature. From 1994 he works in XVIII Gymnasium. He published his first stories 1987 in student newspapers "Studentski list" and "Poletu", and in magazines "Quorum" and "Pitanja". His first book of short stories, *Mišolovku Walta Disneya* was published 1996 (Zagreb, Naklada MD), and for his book of short stories, *Anđeo u ofsajdu* (2000) he has received Gjalski Award and Award of daily paper Jutarnji list. In 2003 he published novel *Smrt djevojčice sa žigicama*, final part of his "black" tripartite. In the same year he published book of essays written as a weekly columns for Croatian magazine "Nacional" entitled *Otpusno pismo*. In 2005 he published novel *Djeca Patrasa* in special summer edition of Jutarnji list. In the bookshop-club "Booksa" he leads creative writing workshop. His books were published in German, Slovenian, English, Polish, Ukrainian and Hungarian.
